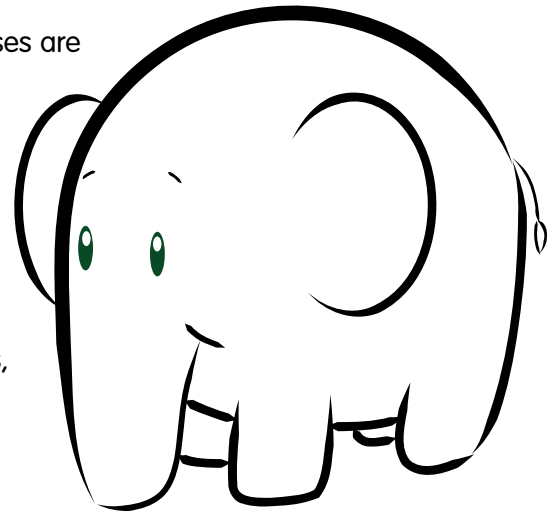


CIRCUSES ARE NO FUN FOR ANIMALS
